Bold City Soccer Academy is committed to creating a positive, respectful, and development-focused environment for all players. As a parent or guardian, you play a critical role in supporting that mission. By joining Bold City Soccer Academy, all parents agree to the following Code of Conduct:

1. Support and Encouragement

- Promote a positive and supportive environment at all times.
- Encourage your child and teammates regardless of the game's outcome.
- Reinforce effort, commitment, sportsmanship, and personal growth over winning.

2. Respect for Coaches and Officials

- Respect the authority and decisions of coaches, referees, and club staff.
- Refrain from coaching your child or other players during practices or games—leave coaching to the coaches.
- Do not confront coaches, referees, or opposing teams during or after games.

3. Communication

- Direct any concerns or questions through the appropriate channels (coach, team manager, or club leadership) at the appropriate time.
- Use respectful and constructive language in all communications.
- Allow 24-hour reflection time before discussing sensitive or emotional topics.

4. Game Day Behavior

- Be a positive spectator—cheer, but do not criticize.
- Never use abusive, offensive, or confrontational language toward players, coaches, referees, or other parents.
- Set an example of sportsmanship for your child and the team.



5. Commitment to the Team

- Ensure your child arrives on time for practices, games, and events.
- Notify coaches in advance of any absences.
- Prioritize team responsibilities and communicate conflicts proactively.

6. Social Media and Public Representation

- Represent the club positively on social media.
- Do not post negative comments about coaches, players, referees, or other teams.
- Understand that online behavior reflects on the club as a whole.

7. Club Policies and Financial Commitment

- Abide by all club policies, procedures, and payment obligations.
- Support the club's efforts to develop players on and off the field.
- Understand that playing time is not guaranteed and is determined by the coaching staff.

Violations of This Code

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in warnings, temporary suspension from attending games, or removal from the club, depending on the severity and frequency of the behavior.
